2 dealing with overall style and the structure and the
3 content and the flow.

4 Do you see that?

5 A. Yes.

6 Q. Does Harvest House subject all of its
7 manuscripts to substantive editing?

8 A. No.

9 Q. Did Harvest House subject the Encyclopedia of
10 Cults and New Religions to substantive editing?

11 A. No.

12 Q. All right. Does substantive editing,
13 particularly checking the structure and content, entail
14 checking statements of fact for their accuracy?

15 A. The editor would check -- probably check more
16 facts in a substantive edit.

17 Q. Why did Harvest House decide not to subject
18 the Encyclopedia of Cults and New Religions to a
19 substantive edit?

20 A. I don't know.

21 Q. Who made that decision?

22 A. That was Betty Fletcher, the managing editor.

23 Q. Do most Harvest House publications get a
24 substantive edit?

25 A. No.
